Dear Hockey friends

As you know, the WMH World Cup will be taking place in Cape Town this October! As we count the days to the tournament, the excitement is growing, and we can't wait to welcome all the different teams, players, and staff to the tournament. We've got all the details you need to know about the event.

THE WORLD MASTERS HOCKEY WORLD CUP

It's a Cashless Event:

Please note the WMH World Cup will be a cashless event. This means that all the vendors at the different match venues will not be able to accept cash and will only be able to accept cards.

The World Cup villages at the Western Province Cricket & Hockey Club and Hartleyvale Hockey Stadium all food vendors, medical services, and any other service provider will only accept card payments including Diners Club and American Express cards.

We have ensured that there will be sufficient Yoko cashless machines available for each vendor to ensure a smooth transaction process. The Yoko card machine will not give you a printed receipt,

however, you are able to request an email receipt at the time of your purchase should you require a proof of purchase. As the hosts of the World Cup, we feel that this will reduce any security risk for participants and suppliers.

Practice Sessions, everything you need to know

Any teams wishing to book astro training sessions are to send an email to Andy Stofberg at andy@psihockey.co.za with the requested dates and times. We will try our best to accommodate team requests as far as date and time are concerned, we might not be able to do so, due to the increased demand for training facilities. .

Training sessions are 01h15 minutes and are based on a ½ field which means that you will be sharing the field with another team. The cost per session is R750. Should teams wish to utilise a full field they should indicate this when sending their requests via email.

Practice balls and warm up prior to matches

We have had several requests from teams with regards to the provision of practice balls for training sessions and pre-match warm-up by the event organizers



With the number of fields being used for the practice sessions, unfortunately we are unable to provide this service.

Our suggestion is that each player packs in two hockey balls, which will then give teams sufficient balls to practice with during their session.

We are excited to announce that we will be involved in a Legacy Project during and after the World Cup and more information will be announced in our next monthly newsletter. Participants who do not wish to travel home with practice balls after the event are more than welcome to donate these to our Development program. These hockey balls will then be distributed to several underprivileged clubs and schools across Cape Town.

Should teams wish to purchase balls and have them delivered to their accommodation upon arrival that can be arranged. The balls are approximately R80 each. The World Masters Hockey, World Cup – Opening Function

We are very excited to announce that the opening function for The World Masters Hockey, World Cup will take place at the iconic Victoria and Alfred Waterfront also known as the V&A Waterfront. Below are all the details you need to know about the event:

Date: Friday, 30th September 2022.

Time: Arrival at 3:30pm and starts at 4pm.

Stay Entertained

The Opening Function will take the form of a “Parade of Nations” through the V&A Waterfront. The undoubted stars of the Cape Carnival, the Cape Minstrels band, consisting of 21 members will welcome you with some famous “Kaapse Klopse” music whilst we arrange teams in a procession format.

Teams will meet at the V&A Harbour. A full map and information will be distributed to all team managers. Teams will line up in alphabetical order led by South Africa and we shall then embark on a public procession through the V&A Waterfront,



across the Clock Tower Bridge and finish up at The Silo Hotel's, open area. This walk is approximately 800 metres. A mere warm up for our elite athletes!

Each country will plant its flag upon arrival followed by the official opening speeches. The open area outside the Silo Hotel is an informal hang-out and consists of a grass verge, seating, and the majority of a large open standing area for all. We expect the finishing time for the grand opening to be no later than 5:15pm and the Cape Minstrels will be there to entertain us until 5:45pm for those who wish to take videos, dance, and simply enjoy the warm welcome to Cape Town.

For those teams who are on the transport solution package – transport to and from this event is included in the package. A collection point has been arranged close to the finishing area so that participants do not have to walk all the way back to the starting point.

The team dress code is entirely up to each country, but we do urge countries to be dressed in similar attire. We urge teams to make a conscious effort to attend this event, to be part of it and for it NOT to be missed.

TRANSPORTATION

Don't Get Left Behind!

Many teams have taken advantage of the transport solution that we are offering. The fleet has just been topped up with another five brand new vehicles which will be incorporated into the tournament.

The transport solution on offer is R200 per player/partner per day, and includes the following:

- Airport transfer from the airport to the hotel on arrival day. One of the World Cup staff members will be there to greet you and escort you to the bus pick-up area.
- Transport to and from all practice sessions.
- Match day team transfers to and from the game.

- Transfers to the World Cup opening function and the World Cup closing function at Grand Africa Café & Beach (with Metro traffic officers' support if required)
- An internal bus system running between venues to allow individuals or teams participating to freely move between venues to watch any matches of their choosing or to visit either of the World Cup Villages.
- An external bus system running from hotels to playing venues. This allows participants to visit the World Cup Village or another venue at any stage during the World Cup.
- Airport shuttle from the hotel to the airport on the day of departure, regardless of the return date.
- 24/7 support Emergency contact number should you require any emergency assistance at any time.

ACTIVITIES

An Activities Desk will be available where enquiries and bookings for transfers, half day tours, full day tours, adventure tours, pre- and post tours, safaris, Garden Route tours and many more can be booked.

Besides the many activities such as the Cape Peninsula Tour, Winelands Tour, Robben Island Tour, Whale Tour, Great White Shark Diving, Township Tour and many more, have a look at the below tours which may wet your appetite.

Safari (Half day, Full day or Overnight tours) from Cape Town

Just 2 hours from Cape Town, situated in the historic town of Touws River, in a valley between the Langeberg and the Outeniqua Mountains in the Karoo, the 10,000 hectare conservancy has evolved from its early days of being residence to various antelope species only to becoming the home of the Africa's Legendary Big 5. A unique opportunity to see Lion, Rhino, Buffalo, Elephant & Leopard, as well as Giraffes, Waterbuck, Oryx, Kudu, Lechwe, Zebra, Bontebok, Red Hartebeest, Springbok, Gemsbok, Steenbok, Caracal (Lynx) Blesbok, Fox, Jackal, Baboon, Black Wildebeest, Cheetah, Impala & Hippo's. Additional wildlife and flora is available to view on the once-in-a-lifetime game drives.

Half day tour: Includes Welcome Drinks, 2-3 hour Game Drive & Buffet Lunch.

Full day tour: Includes Welcome Drinks, Buffet Breakfast, 2-3 hour Game Drive & Buffet Lunch.

Overnight tour: Includes Accommodation as well as Welcome Drinks on arrival, Buffet Lunch, 2-3 hour Game Drive, Buffet Dinner, 2-3 hour Game Drive and Buffet Breakfast.

Kruger National Park safari - 3 Day / 2 Night
